Accommodations

This flushdeck trawler offers many desirable features. The salon has a leather sofa to port and starboard, to starboard and teak cabinetry forward. Starboard is an hallway with a graceful stairway to the staterooms, the galley to port and pilothouse forward. The Pilothouse has two waterproof wing doors, a large chart table & helm bench seat. Three staterooms are below with twin bunks to port and a full sized to starboard and shower/head aft. A large, full-beam mid-ship master features a centerline queen bed and bath starboard and forward. Also featured are opening large stainless hull windows, a desk to starboard, a settee to port and plenty of bookshelves and storage. A separate stateroom (crew or guests) with two berths and a head is entered either through the engine room or aft deck.

Flooring throughout is attractive dark wood with maple inlays. The cabinetry is satin-finished teak. Countertops and showers are granite. Overhead panels and walls are attractive vinyl panels.

Galley

Twin opposing black granite countertops, plenty of lighting and durable/attractive flooring make this galley a pleasure to prepare meals in.

Engine Room & Mechanical

The engine room is access via the starboard forward aft deck and features plenty of accessibility with stand-up headroom. Flooring is polished "diamond-plate". Fuel tanks run full beam across engine room (access plates and sight gauges). Engine exhausts are wet, muffled and vent through the hullsides above the waterline.

Hull and Deck

The hull and deck are built of steel. All main decks are covered in teak. The covered aft deck features a built-in settee with a beautiful custom table. Twin stairs access the swim platform.

Access to the flybridge is via a stairway on the port aft deck (w/rain hatch). The Flybridge features a large semi-circular settee with a table and a helm station (with bench seat) forward. Also forward of the helm is a sunpad area. Overhead is a radar arch. Aft on the Flybridge is plenty of room for a tender.

Forward along walkaround decks is a Portuguese bridge with two watertight wing doors to the pilothouse. The foredeck features fender storage on either side with a roomy bench seat.

The hull is painted Grey and the deckhouse and gunwales are painted white. The flybridge deck is painted non-skid.
